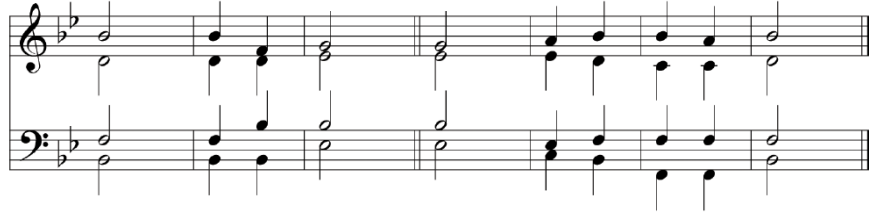
- 1 My soul doth / magni fy the / Lord,*
