



Missa pro Defunctis

These chants date from the 12th through the 14th century. The beauty of these elegant, simple chants has inspired the composition of some of the great choral and orchestral works in the classical repertoire. During the late Middle Ages, this setting became associated with “*Requiems*” and Votive Masses for the Dead. The segments of the mass included above may be sung for any Eucharist. At *Requiems*, the text for the *Agnus Dei* is indicated in parentheses, and the final phrase “*sempiternam*” is added.

The use of Latin texts for the Ordinary of a Eucharist is permitted according to the rubrics of *The Book of Common Prayer*, page. 14.
