To whom it may concern:

- 1. Nashotah House has signed and returned the Certification and Agreement to the Department of Education and will use no less than fifty percent of the funds to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students.
- 2. We are approved for \$8438 in funding for students.
- 3. \$8438 has been distributed to students.
- 4. Twenty-nine students were eligible to participate.
- 5. Sixteen students have received an Emergency Financial Aid Grant.
- 6. All residential students were invited to submit a signed affidavit stating that they were affected by COVID-19 and would use the money received toward those costs. Grants were distributed equally to students who submitted an affidavit through our student portal, Populi. Refunds were immediately generated for direct payment to the students through bill.com.
- 7. Students were advised that eligible expenses included food, housing, course materials, technology, health care, child care, or any additional student-related expenses and that they needed to be eligible for Federal Financial Aid to receive this grant.
